Options and Eligibility Criteria for FREE Early Education

FREE early education is available if your child is **age 2**, you live in England and get one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit, and your household income is £15,400 a year or less after tax, not including benefit payments.
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit tax credits
- Child Tax Credit, Working Tax Credit (or both), and your household income is £16,190 a year or less before tax.
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

2-year-olds can also get free childcare if they:

- they're looked after by a local council.
- have an education, health and care (EHC) plan.
- get Disability Living Allowance
- have left care under an adoption order, special guardianship order or a child arrangements order.

All children **aged 3 to 4** in England are eligible for the universal entitlement of 15 hours per term week free early education. The entitlement stops when your child starts in reception class (or reaches compulsory school age, if later).

The **2yr working parents funding** (April 2024) or extended entitlement of **30 hours free** childcare or can be applied for if you (and your partner, if you have one) are:

- in work - or getting parental leave, sick leave, or annual leave.
- each earning at least the National Minimum Wage or Living Wage for 16 hours a week on average.

Applying for 2yr working parents funding (April 2024) or 30 hours free childcare

You'll need your details (and your partner's, if you have one), including your:

- National Insurance number
- Unique Taxpayer Reference (UTR) if you're self-employed.

It takes approximately 20 minutes to apply online at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. You may find out if you're eligible straight away, but it can take up to 7 days. If you're eligible for the extra hours, you sign up online to get a code which you must give to pre-school together with your National Insurance number and date of birth to reserve your place. Subject to availability, the extra hours can begin once the next term starts.
